The Commission for the Classification of the Saint-Emilion Grand Cru appellation 2022, under the aegis of the INAO, has just elevated Château-Figeac to Premier Grand Cru Classé "A".

It is a recognition of the exceptional qualities of its terroir, the excellent wines it produces each vintage, and its singularity within Saint-Emilion and Bordeaux.
